

The National Legal Services Authority in collaboration with Delhi State Legal Services Authority and Bachpan Bachao Andolan through All India Legal Aid Cell on Child Rights organised a National Workshop on Rehabilitation of missing and trafficked children on 22nd August, 2016 at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi. From the deliberations at the workshop a Draft Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) emerged as per which one Co-ordinator (from among the Retainer Lawyer) would be designated in each State Legal Services Authority and District Legal Services Authority for supporting child protecton agencies. A copy of the SOP is enclosed herewith.

Accordingly Co-ordinators have been appointed in the Kerala State Legal Services Authority and District Legal Services Authorities in all districts to co-ordinate with all the Stakeholders at the State/District level in terms of Draft SOP for rehabilitation of missing and trafficked children. The details of Co-ordinators appointed in KeLSA and DLSAs are attached herewith for favour of information and necessary co-ordination in terms of Draft SOP for rehabilitation of missing and trafficked children.

Adv. Sherly S.A. will co-ordinate with the stakeholders concerned in compliance with the Standard Operating Procedure and submit periodical report to the Member Secretary, Kerala State Legal Services Authority; Draft SOP is enclosed for reference.

1. Child Welfare Committees (CWC)

- Mechanisms for 'Co-ordination' for Repatriation/ Rehabilitation and other trafficking issues:
- 1. One coordinator would be designated in each DLSA and SLSA.
- The coordinator would build up linkages with CWCs, JJBs, Police Department, DCPU, NGOs, CCIs, AHTU, ChildLine and all relevant stakeholders.
- -3. The information regarding a recovered/trafficked child would be received by the coordinator
- 4.—The coordinator would then co-ordinate with the concerned stakeholders including Police, DCPU, NGOs, for purpose of verification of address of the child in case the child belongs to another district or states, he would convey the information to the concerned coordinator in the other DLSA/ SLSA who would likewise coordinate in their district/ state.
- 5. After verification of address of the child, the coordinator would convey the information to the CWC.
- 6. The LSA of recovered district would then co-ordinate with CWC of concerned district regarding re-integration of the child with the family/repatriation of the child to the home district.
- 7. The coordinator would also ensure that the child is produced before the CWC of the home district so that the case of the child would be followed up.
- 8. The coordinator will ensure that Legal Aid is given to the child at all stages for protection, rescue, rehabilitation and trial of the criminal case.
