### Study on Psycho Social Rehabilitation needs of Women Prisoners/ex-Prisoners/Probationers

Apart from the implementation of the Probation of Offenders Act 1950, the Department of Social Justice is involved in several other activities in the field of Social Defence which includes legal awareness programs, job skills training, and self employment assistance to the probationers, first offenders, victims and dependents of prisoners etc These activities are conducted in collaboration with various other stake holders like prison department , police ,judiciary and NGOs . These initiatives play a crucial role in reducing recidivism and to ensure rehabilitation and reintegration of the persons in conflict with law

Several studies have shown that the socio-psychological-economic and family background plays a major role in predisposing a person to crime. Adverse life circumstances, such as poverty, lack of education, unemployment, unstable family environments, and exposure to violence, can contribute to criminal involvement. Hence it is important to plan preventive interventions . Experiences inside the prison may also have negative effect on the individual. A person who was in prison faces lots of stigma from the society after their release and they often end up in the same situations that led to their crime.

The emotional, physical and psychological conditions, needs, experiences and challenges of female prisoners/offenders are quite different from those of male prisoners/offenders . There is no data on the specific issues of women offender . Gender-specific schemes and programmes are necessary to address the unique and specific issues of of women prisoners, ex-prisoners, and women probationers and hence a study titled Psycho Social Rehabilitation needs of Women Prisoners/ex-Prisoners/Probationers is proposed with the following objectives

#### Objectives

1. To understand the socio-demographic background of women prisoners/ex-prisoners/probationers in Kerala that lead to their involvement in criminal activities.
2. Understand the mental health experiences of those incarcerated.
3. Identify changes that need to be made by studying educational opportunities, legal aid, health care and other rehabilitation support activities currently available to women prisoners.
4. Identify the specific challenges faced by women prisoners/ex prisoners and probationers , including family support, living conditions, reintegration of those in prisons into the community after release, and related issues.
5. To evaluate the effectiveness of existing policies and interventions aimed at rehabilitation of women prisoners, women ex-prisoners and probationers in Kerala and recommend further improved activities/projects based on research findings.
6. Identify policy recommendations and potential areas of intervention based on their specific needs.

An Expression of Interest prepared in the prescribed format as per Annexure-1 is invited from Universities, Colleges, Research Institutes and Voluntary Organizations for conducting the said

Information to be included in the proposal

- Project Proposal – A detailed project proposal containing the following information regarding the proposed study should be provided..
  - Detailed methodology -Background of the proposed Study, ,Detailed problem statement, Review of earlier studies in the Subject, sample selection, data collection tools and methods,
  - details and qualification of the project staff, additional Terms of reference for the proposed study (if any), time line, etc.
- A brief report containing information on previous research studies.
  - Those who have done research projects in the field of Prisoners/ex-prisoners/Probationers and those who have done major national/international research projects will be given due weightage.
- Information about the institution
  - will be evaluated based on service capability, Depth of resources, Evidence of ethics, Legal and economic stability, Past performance, Experience in performing similar studies, Nature and quality of work done within last five years, Demonstrated ability to meet the project deadlines, Organizational structure, Qualification, Knowledge education and experience of the personnel, overall project schedule etc.
- Budget Plan
  - Item wise expected cost of the activities proposed to be carried out as part of the project (To be furnished along with the proposal in a specially prepared sealed envelope) )

Project technical inspection criteria are given below.(Total - 50 Points)



The proposals received on the basis of the letter of interest will be examined by the technical committee and the final decision will be taken by giving weightage of 80:20 respectively to the technical score and budget of the proposals recommended by the departmental technical committee. If eligible to get marks in items 2 and 3 of the technical evaluation criteria, the necessary documents to prove the eligibility should be provided along with the application. A detailed presentation should be made before the technical committee including the information required in item (1). The Director of Social Justice shall have the authority to scrutinize proposals not submitted with sufficient documentation and seek additional information from eligible applicants or reject proposals unconditionally.
